### Catechism Question: (1/3)

Children's Catechism (2 - 5 y.o.) -

Q. 30. What is meant by transgression?

**A. Doing what God forbids.**

Shorter Catechism ( 6+ y.o.):

Q. 39. What is the duty that God requires of mankind?

**A. The duty which God requires of mankind is obedience to his revealed will.**

## DAILY DEVOTIONS

### Day 1 (Sunday March 8 )

Reading: I Kings 1

Questions:

- What did David's son (Absalom's brother) do to his father, David? What prophecy was fulfilled here?
- What advice did Nathan the prophet give to Bathsheba for David? What do you think of Nathan and Bathsheba's plan?
- What happened for Solomon?

Prayer for: For 2 un-churched people you know (by name)

### Day 2 - Monday

Reading: I Kings 2

Questions:

- From a spiritual standpoint, summarize the counsel David gave Solomon.
- From a kingdom standpoint, summarize the counsel David gave Solomon. What is "sheol?"
- Name the people Solomon had killed. Why did he do this?

Prayer for: For friends, relatives, neighbors who don't have saving faith in Jesus

### Day 3 - Tuesday

Reading: I Kings 3

Questions:

- How does chapter 3 describe Solomon's relationship with God?

- Describe Solomon's request of / prayer to God.
- What account does the chapter give to illustrate Solomon's wisdom?

Prayer for: For the Lord to renew your mind with His truth

#### **Day 4 - Wednesday**

Reading: I Kings 4

Questions:

- What does the chapter tell us about Solomons administration of the kingdom thru his officers?
- Describe Solomons kingdom, from 4: 20 – 31.
- What does 4: 32 – 34 tell us about Solomon's wisdom and proverbs? What is a "proverb"?

Prayer for: The Great Commission to be fulfilled

#### **Day 5 - Thursday**

Reading: I Kings 5

Questions:

- What great work did Solomon begin? How did he explain his plans to do what David had not done?
- What was Hiram's involvement in the Temple project?
- Describe Solomon's labor force for the project.

Prayer for: God's help and guidance in sharing the Gospel with others

#### **Day 6 - Friday**

Reading: I Kings 6

Questions:

- What timeframe reference does I Kings 6 give for the Temple's construction?
- Describe the Temple Solomon built
- What conditional promise did God make Solomon for his work building the Temple?

Prayer for: The people serving in local state and national government

#### **Day 7 - Saturday**

Reading: I Kings 7

Questions:

- What next great construction project did Solomon take on? How long did it take?
- What impressed you about the Temple furnishings in 7: 13ff?

Prayer for: God's protection and blessing on 1st Responders (police, fire, EMS, etc)
