

## Weekly Discipleship Plan (Week of May 17 – 23, 2026 )

### Catechism Question: (3/4)

#### Children's Catechism

Q. 33. What befell our first parents when they had sinned?

A. Instead of being holy and happy, they became sinful and miserable.

Q. 34. Did Adam act for himself alone in the covenant of works?

A. No; he represented all his posterity.

#### Shorter Catechism

Q42. What is the essence of the ten commandments?

A: The essence of the ten commandments is to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our strength, and with all our mind, and to love everyone else as we love ourselves.

Q43. What introduces the ten commandments?

A: These words introduce the ten commandments: "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery."

Scripture Memory: **1John 5:13** ¶ I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life. **5:14** And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. **5:15** And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him.

### DAILY DEVOTIONS

#### **Day 1 (Sunday May 17 )**

Reading: II Chron 15 – 16

Questions:

- What was Azariah's "If... then" challenge to King Asa?
- What are some of the things Asa did in response?
- What's your take on King Asa taking silver and gold out of Solomon's Temple to make a treaty with the king of Syria? What did the prophet Hanani say about it in 16:7ff?

Prayer for: For 2 un-churched people you know (by name)

#### **Day 2 - Monday**

Reading: II Chron 17 – 18

Questions:

- What was God's action toward King Jehoshaphat? Why?
- What alliance did Jehospaht, king of Judah, make with Ahab the king of Israel? What did the prophets say about it?
- Discuss a "random" arrow hitting Ahab, king of Israel, despite his disguise.

Prayer for: II Cor 1:7 – That as we share in suffering for Christ, we also receive His comfort

### **Day 3 - Tuesday**

Reading: II Chron 19

Questions:

- What did Hanani say about Jehoshaphat helping the those who hate the Lord?
- What good thing did Hanani say about Jehoshaphat?
- What good things did Jehoshaphat do will living in Jerusalem? (19: 4 – 11)

Prayer for: Micah 6: 8 – That we do what is just, and love what is kind, and walk humbly with God.

### **Day 4 - Wednesday**

Reading: II Chron 20

Questions:

- What threat confronted Jehoshaphat?
- How did he respond ? (20: 3 – 12)
- What was God's instruction about the threat from the Ammonites and Moabites?

Prayer for: Phil 4: 6 – 7 To make request of God for every situation, rather than to be anxious about circumstances.

### **Day 5 - Thursday**

Reading: II Chron 21 – 22

Questions:

- How did Jehoshaphat's reign end ? (end of Ch. 20 & Ch. 21)
- Why did God not fully destroy Jehoshaphat's son, despite his great wickedness? What did God do instead?
- Describe Ahaziah's reign, and his mother's influence on him.

Prayer for: God's help and guidance in sharing the Gospel with others`

### **Day 6 - Friday**

Reading: II Chron 23 -24

Questions:

- What part did the Levites play in establishing Joash's throne?
- Who was Jehoida, and what reforms did he put in place?
- How old was Joash when he began to reign over Israel? Describe his reign, initially. How did his reign as king end?

Prayer for: The people serving in local state and national government

### **Day 7 - Saturday**

Reading: II Chron 25

Questions:

- Describe the various kings named thus far in II Chronicles. How did Amaziah compare to them?
- What wrong thing did Amaziah do in 25:14?
- What was God's intended punishment of Amaziah? (25:20)

Prayer for: Num 6 – For God to bless us, keep us and make His face shine on us.
